ABSTRACT

There is so far lack of research has been conducted concerning the Quality of Training, Type of Course, Duration of the Course on Creating Entrepreneurship and Youth Employment. This research study plan to examine that problem and fulfil the empirical gap in youth who followed Vocational Training in Vocational Training Authority in Kanthale. The aim of the present research is to investigate the effect of creating entrepreneurship and youth employment.

Precisely, the study focused on evaluating the effect of selected variables. Quality of Training, Type of Course, Duration of the Course primary data were collected via questionnaire.
