Energy is one of the basic necessities of humans. We need energy in its various forms and various theories have been propounded and experiments conducted for the proper consumption, production and preservation of energy.

With the demand for energy increasing, scientists are making <u>headway</u> in their endeavors to find new sources of energy. The <u>concept</u> of renewable energy has become quite popular in the last two or three decades.

Various methods of generating renewable forms of energy have been introduced in the recent past. One concept that is fast gaining ground is that of the biogas. Biogas in used as a renewable source of energy, which utilizes available natural resources for its production.

Biogas can be described as a <u>combination</u> of various gases, usually carbon dioxide and methane. Though both these gases support combustion, methane is sometimes referred to as biogas. Methane is generated <u>an aerobically</u> through the process of fermentation, in which certain micro-organisms of different types act on organic material like manure, mud and solid waste. These methane-producing micro-organism are not just able to live without oxygen, but they can also <u>digested</u> cellulose, which is the main constituent of plant fiber.

These <u>microbes</u> are very responsible to environmental conditions like temperature, acidity and water. Animals which <u>consume</u> plants, like grazing creatures, produce considerable amount of biogas. That is, the microbes present in their digestive systems produce biogas.

Biogas is also produced in swamps and at the bottom of lakes where, under wet conditions, organic matter is generated which decays under anaerobic conditions.
