ROLE OF INTRINSIC INVOLVEMENT (WITH SPECIAL REFERENCE TO
GOVERNMENT SCHOOLS IN KOTHTALE DIVISION OF NUWARA

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ABSTRACT

This study investigated the Social Loafing(SL), Group Performance(GP) and Intrinsic Involvement(II) and moderate impact of Intrinsic Involvement(II) to relationship among Social Loafing and Group Performance(GP). In Sri Lankan context, there is so far lack of research has been conducted concerning the social loafing on group performance involving role of intrinsic involvement among schools students. This research study plan to examine that problem and fulfill the empirical gap in schools students. Therefore, the aim of this study was to analyze existing level of Social Loafing, Group Performance and Intrinsic Involvement, what sort of impact between Social Loafing and Group Performance and moderate impact of Intrinsic Involvement to relationship among Social Loafing and Group Performance at government schools in Kothmale division of Nuwara Eliya. In concentrated on Social Loafing related to Apathy, Distractive Disruptive Behavior, Poor Work Quality and Expects Others to Pick up the Slack. In concentrated on Group Performance related to System Viability, Task Effectiveness and Professional Growth and In concentrated on Intrinsic Involvement related to Task Significance, Task Meaningfulness and Contribution.

Structured questionnaire was used as the method of data collection and 224 advanced level students selected as sample out of 508 advanced level students. Researcher considered three government schools name as CP/KOT/Gamini Dissanayaka national school, CP/KOT/AL-Minhaj national school and CP/KOT/Jayahela national school. Stratified sampling method used to make the sampling frame of the study. Quantitative research approach used for this study. The data were analysed using descriptive statistics, correlation and regression analysis. The descriptive result indicated that the Social Loafing was low level and Group Performance and Intrinsic Involvement were high level in selected schools. Correlation result indicated that the Social Loafing and Group performance have negative relationship. And also regression result indicated that significant negative impact among Social Loafing and Group Performance and significant moderate impact of Intrinsic Involvement to relationship between Social Loafing and Group Performance. As a result of this study, principals must give more opportunities for Group Performance and decrease Social Loafing and increase Intrinsic Involvement among students.
