THE PRESENT STATE OF HEALTH SERVICE IN MUTHUR D.S DIVISION AND IT'S DEVELOPMENT



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ABSTRACT

Health service is an important pillar of human life. Health services are provided as a free service to all citizens of SriLanka. Health service is being undeveloped condition up to now in some part of the area of Srilanka.

In this research, identify and analyze the problems that are faced by public receiving the health services and also find some ways to develop the health services. Development health service as an input factor for the output of satisfaction level in preventive and curative health service is abstract. Dependent and independent variables are formulated to the research purpose. Dependent variable is development of health services and independent variables are immunization activities, mutrition, safe water, sewage solid waste disposal, health education activities impatient care, and outpatient care.

The population of this study is 61000 individuals those are living in Muthur Divisional Sectratiate Division. Two hundred individuals are taken as samples from four hospitals and twelve clinics centers. The research data are collected using questionnaire. The collected data have been analyzed by SPSS (computer package) with descriptive statistics. According to the data analyzed immunization, mutrition, safe water, sewage solid waste disposal, health education and out patient service show moderate satisfaction level of health service. In patient service show low level of satisfaction of health service. Through this study some recommendations are suggested to develop this area health services.

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
