

**A study on the effectiveness of the rehabilitation programmes of  
the Centre for Human Resource Development (CHRD) in  
rehabilitate the beneficiaries in Eravur Pattu Divisional  
Secretariat division**



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## ABSTRACT

As the consequences of violence continuing after 1990, the socio-economic well-being of the people living in this division becomes worse. The people could not initiate new self employment ventures and even continue their routine employment activities because lack of financial facilities, infrastructure, raw material, technical knowledge etc. In order to improve this situation CHRD are implemented several projects. So many projects were carried out in division, even through the beneficiaries still not rehabilitated properly.

The main objective of this research study is to identify about the effectiveness of the rehabilitation programmes that are being undertaken the CHRD, based on the satisfaction of the people those who are coming under the programmes.

The qualitative and quantitative research approach specifically designed to evaluate the key success factors for the effectiveness of the past activities of the CHRD which had played in rehabilitation programmes in Eravur Pattu division. 100 Questionnaires were issued to beneficiaries who are residing Eravur Pattu divisional secretariat division.

Collected data analysed through the SPSS package. Frequency distribution, mean and standard deviation are used to determine the effectiveness of the rehabilitation programmes.

According to this study it was found that the moderate satisfaction among the beneficiaries with regard to the rehabilitation programmes. As beneficiaries are said to be at moderate satisfied state, Rehabilitation programmes of CHRD in rehabilitating the beneficiaries in Eravur Pattu Divisional Secretariat division are found that it was not fully effectiveness. Hence, by identifying the needs, planning and coordinating rehabilitation programmes by CHRD, rehabilitation takes may be implemented effectively.

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
