

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## Abstract

Accordingly factors of career choice are problem solving, working with others, personal management skill, learning, participating in task, abilities, challenging work, interest, job security, risk taking, involvement, work experience, income, performance, apportunity, social responsibility and education and factors of career satisfaction are reward system, feedback, interference, working environment, co-workers, work satisfaction and job attraction.

Findings for the first objective, Challenging work is highly influence in career choice, and work satisfaction is highly influence in career satisfaction. Objective two, this indicates career choice inpacts on career satisfaction in low level and positive relationship between career choice and career satisfaction in DS offices' offficer grade employees.
