

ABSTRACT

Small business contributes greatly to economy all around the word. Most of businesses are small business or even started out as small businesses. They contribute to society by offers products to customers. They also provide employment opportunities to people which can become reasonable career paths and choices. It brings a new kind of competitions and also open up business opportunities as well as high performing institutions are the leading players of small business development in the global economy there are insufficient capital problem in Sri Lanka. So capital requires increasing the small businesses in Sri Lanka. Small business which can be started with less investment is very significant.
