ABSTRACT

Development of a country mostly depends on its infrastructure development. The infrastructure means the basic necessities such Electricity, Telecommunication, Water, Transportation facilities and there are so many others. How ever this infrastructure is divided in two categories. Those are Economic and Social. For example we consider a construction of a factory in a specified location in automatically requires these basic necessities. If these basic necessities are inadequate in a place or an area development will be delayed or reduced automatically.

This research study leads to a corporate plan for the development on infrastructure in the Eachchilampaththai Divisional Secretariat Division. The most of research areas are not under the Government. There fore the Government activities toward the infrastructure facilities are very less. Hence the more facilities are in very poor condition in this area for last decades.

The objective is to identifying the present level of infrastructure in Eachchilampaththai D.S Division, to formulating objectives towards the development of infrastructure in this division, to formulating the corporate plan for the development of infrastructure in the Eachchilampaththi D.S.Division.

Conceptualization model includes Water, Electricity, Transport, Telecommunication. To analyze the present level of infrastructure in this division 200 families were taken as sample from 9 Grama Niladhari Division of Eachchilampaththai D.S. Division. The data was collected by the issuing questionnaire and it was analyzed through SPSS package and spread sheet. The result are illustrated by pie chart.

These four infrastructure facilities are found to be very less in many places. Some of facilities are not at all available in certain areas. According to the identify these problem to recommended that improving the existing water supply, providing the electricity facilities, expand the bus and boat services and providing the telephone facilities.

This study will help and provide all necessary information those who want to develop the infrastructure facilities in Eachchilampaththai D.S. Division, Trincomalee.
