ABSTRACT

This survey was evaluate the occupancy satisfaction of housing in Thiraimadu area .In Thiraimadu division the people affected by Tsunami were resettled, several NGO'O, INGO'O and Local authorities built housing scheme for them. The main objective of this research is to evaluate the occupancy satisfaction about housing and find out the ways and means to improve occupancy satisfaction in future.

The variables included in this survey were Structure of house, Environment, Site, Social aspect and Livelihood. To measure these variables data collected from sample 150 families in Thiraimadu area, using proportionate random sampling technique. The collected data were analyzed using the univariate method. The data collected were presented in the form of table and pie charts. The data gathered were analyzed using the Microsoft Excel 2003 package and SPSS 13.0 version.

The findings showed that, the Thiraimadu division people in moderately satisfaction level with housing. Reason for that, insufficient infrastructure facilities, lack of Kitchen facilities, lack of drinking water, inefficient wastage removing facilities, improper access facilities, facing social security problems, lack of employment facilities and difficult to get nutritious foods therefore, chapter seven has recommended for the above issues.
