## A STUDY ON FACTORS CONTRIBUTE TO THE SUCCESSFUL IMPLEMENTATION OF 5S CONCEPT AND ITS IMPACT ON ORGANIZATIONAL PERFORMANCE IN DIVISIONAL SECRETARIAT OF BATTICALOA DISTRICT

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## ABSTRACT

Total quality management has been widely considered as the strategic, tactical and operational tool in the quality management. In the frames of the implementation of the Total Quality Management, a 5S concept is a popular method and it is a technique used to establish and maintain a quality environment in an organization. The major aim of this study is to identify the factors contribute to the successful implementation of 5S concept and its impact on organizational performance in Divisional Secretariat of Batticaloa District. Primary data was collected from the employees of three productivity award winning Divisional Secretariat of Batticaloa District. Simple random sampling was used to obtain 112 responses from employees. Data were analyzed and evaluated by Univariate, Bivariate and Multivariate techniques. The results revealed that Top Management Committeent, Employee Involvement, Employee Encouragement and Training and Education have the high level of contribution in the 5S implementation. There is a strong positive relationship between the factors and organizational performance. This study investigates whether Top Management Commitment, Employee Involvement, Employee Encouragement and Training and Education have an impact on organizational performance in Divisional Secretariat of Batticaloa District. It was found that Top Management Commitment, Employee Encouragement and Training and Education are significantly impact on the organizational performance, and Employee Involvement is not significantly impact on organizational performance. Among these four factor employee encouragement is a more significant factor has an impact on organizational performance. Eventually, this report suggested recommendation to improve the factors of 58 implementation to achieve the high organizational performance in Divisional Secretariat of Batticaloa District.
